- Located adjacent to our Shannon Free Zone business park and home to the longest Category 2 runway in Ireland at 3200 metres long and 45 metres wide with 8 metre shoulders each side.
- > 30 Aircraft stands on-site with 50 long-term storage stands.

- North Atlantic Air Traffic Control is based in Shannon: westbound departing flights have direct access to optimum transatlantic tracks and levels (saving fuel and time).

In 2010 Shannon Airport was the first airport in the world outside of the US to offer full US Customs & Immigration preclearance for General Aviation. It is still the only airport in either Europe or the Middle East with this unique service. This allows aircraft which are precleared at Shannon to fly directly to over 200 U.S airports. Shannon Preclearance has become a major success story and is now widely used by the business aviation industry.
